### Annual Consultation Timetable

#### Interim Consultation Paper (ICP)

On 21 December 2018, the Queensland Competition Authority (the QCA) published its ICP for the task of setting regulated retail electricity prices (notified prices) for regional Queensland for 2019–20.

The ICP was produced in accordance with a Delegation to determine notified prices for 2019–20, given to the QCA by the Minister for Natural Resources, Mines and Energy (the Minister) under section 90AA(1) of the *Electricity Act 1994*.

The QCA invited submissions about the ICP, with the deadline for submissions being 18 January 2019. All non-confidential submissions received have now been published on the QCA's website, and can be accessed at [www.qca.org.au](http://www.qca.org.au)

#### Consultation Timetable

The ICP included an indicative timetable for conducting consultation, and developing draft and final determinations, for notified prices for 2019–20.

The QCA has now revised this timetable to more clearly specify some consultation milestones. The revised timetable is set out as follows:
