2016 QCA Fee Framework Consultation

I refer to your letter (your reference 1173059) dated 11 February 2016 inviting submissions on QCA's proposed 2016 Fee Framework.

Thank you for giving us the opportunity to comment on the proposed Fee Framework. Seqwater accepts that QCA expenses should be met by the entities that it regulates and reflects work undertaken on behalf of the water users of South East Queensland.

Of more importance to Seqwater is the continuation of the collaborative approach undertaken during the previous price path review. Our joint efforts delivered real and substantial value to the community.
