## Regulated retail electricity prices for 2023-24

We have received two delegations from the Minister for Energy, Renewables and Hydrogen (the Minister) to set regulated retail electricity prices (notified prices) to apply in regional Queensland in 2023–24, including two new time-of-use retail energy tariffs for small customers. We received these delegations from the Minister under section 90AA of the *Electricity Act 1994*.

Today, we published an interim consultation paper (ICP). This is the first step in our price review process and provides information on key issues we need to consider when we set notified prices for 2023–24. The ICP and the Minister's delegations are available on our website.

## Timetable for our review

The following table sets out key milestones for this review, including when we intend to publish reports and consult with stakeholders:
