**NOTICE OF A DECISION UNDER SECTION 39(1)**  
**SIGNIFICANT BUSINESS ACTIVITIES**

**1. Decision**

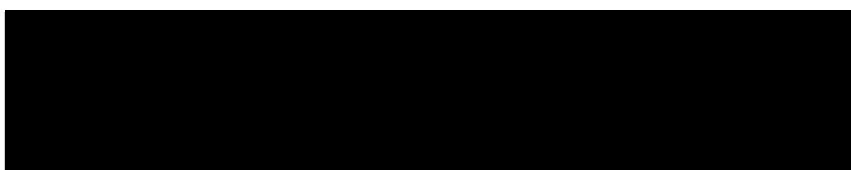
I, the Honourable Cameron Dick MP, Deputy Premier, Treasurer and Minister for Trade and Investment, as Minister administering the *Queensland Competition Authority Act 1997 (QCA Act)*, have decided under section 39(1) of the QCA Act that:

- (a) the business activities of the following government agencies are significant business activities under section 39(3)(a) of the QCA Act:
- Centre for Information Technology and Communication (also known as CITEC);
  - QFleet;
  - QBuild;
  - Queensland Rail Limited;
  - Roadtek;
  - Gladstone Area Water Board;
  - Mount Isa Water Board;
  - TAFE Queensland.

**2. Definitions**

Terms used in this notice are as defined in the QCA Act.

For the avoidance of doubt, "business activities" means "a trading in goods and services" in the QCA Act. Where goods or services are provided by a government agency without receiving a fee or charge in exchange for the goods or services, the provision of those goods or services is not within the definition of business activities and therefore not a "significant business activity" for the purpose of section 39(3) of the QCA Act.
