## Notice of Time Periods QR Network's Draft Amending Access Undertaking – Extension of Termination Date

On 30 October 2009, QR Network Pty Ltd (QR Network) submitted a draft amending access undertaking (DAAU) which proposed to extend the termination date of the 2008 undertaking from 31 December 2009 to 31 May 2010.

On 2 November 2009, the Queensland Competition Authority (the Authority) sought submissions from stakeholders in respect of QR Network's proposed extension. Stakeholders were requested to lodge submissions by 16 November 2009.

## Time periods

In accordance with s.147A of the *Queensland Competition Authority Act 1997* (the QCA Act), the Authority must endeavour to decide whether to approve a DAAU within six months from the last day of the time for making submissions stated in the investigation notice.

The six-month period does not include any of the following periods:

- (a) a day in the period given by the Authority for making submissions in relation to a DAU or a related document;
- (b) a day in the period where a person has been required to give information or produce a document in response to a notice given by the Authority under s.185 of the QCA Act; and
- (c) day(s) agreed to, by the owner or operator of the service or the responsible person, as not being included in the six-month period.

## Six-month period for QR Network's DAAU

In accordance with s.147A(4) of the QCA Act, the Authority states the following time periods for QR Network's DAAU:

- (a) the six-month period commenced on 16 November 2009; and
- (b) the six-month period ends on 16 May 2010.

The six-month period does not include the following days:
