Application for a ruling on the pricing method for the 8X expansion

Extension of submission closing date

On 29th of March, we commenced an investigation into Dalrymple Bay Infrastructure Management's (DBIM's) application for a ruling on the pricing method applicable to the 8X expansion and sought submissions from interested parties.

Following a request from stakeholders, **we have decided to extend the closing date for submissions to 4 June 2021**. We consider that this extension to the consultation period will allow stakeholders sufficient time to engage with DBIM for the purpose of providing informed submissions on DBIM's application.

Submissions

Submissions are invited from interested parties concerning its assessment of DBIM's application for a ruling on the pricing method applicable to the 8X expansion.

Closing date for submissions: 4 June 2021

The QCA will take account of all submissions received within the stated timeframes.

Confidentiality

In the interests of transparency and to promote informed discussion and consultation, the QCA intends to make all submissions publicly available. However, if a person making a submission believes that information in the submission is confidential, that person should claim confidentiality in respect of the document (or the relevant part of the document) at the time the submission is given to the QCA and state the basis for the confidentiality claim.

The assessment of confidentiality claims will be made by the QCA in accordance with the *Queensland Competition Authority Act 1997*, including an assessment of whether disclosure of the information would damage the person's commercial activities and considerations of the public interest.

Claims for confidentiality should be clearly noted on the front page of the submission. The relevant sections of the submission should also be marked as confidential, so that the remainder of the document can be made publicly

available. It would also be appreciated if two versions of the submission (i.e. a complete version and another excising confidential information) could be provided.

A confidentiality claim template is available on request. We encourage stakeholders to use this template when making confidentiality claims. The confidentiality claim template provides guidance on the type of information that would assist our assessment of claims for confidentiality.
